Before you schedule a telephone consultation

Please read

- The doctor will verify your identity during the phone consultation using 3 identifiers.
- **4** Be in a quite room during the telephone consultation
- **4** Do not put the phone on speaker or car Bluetooth
- Clinical photos and documents can be emailed to <u>admin@eppingroadfamilyclinic.com.au</u>
- The call may disconnect during the consultation. The doctor will try to call you back.
- During the telephone consultation, there may be times where there are pauses/silences when the doctor is looking up information in, or typing notes into, your record. The doctor will still be listening to you.
- The temporary changes to providing prescriptions to patients mean we can email or fax a digital copy of a prescription to your email and/or your chosen pharmacy.
- Signatures are not required on pathology or diagnostic imaging requests, nor on referrals to other specialists. They are still required for medical certificates.
